* Prizes for winners of each heat provided by the Tarrytown Sheraton Hotel and the Doubletree Hotel Tarrytown

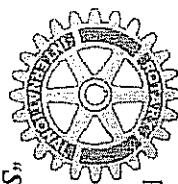



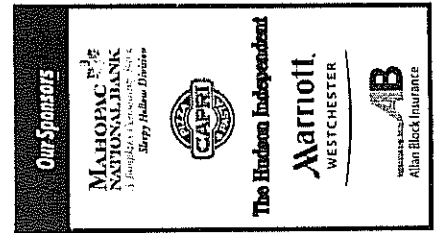
